
New York Museum of Science Fiction

A year-round museum dedicated to science fiction in movies, television, art, and literature.



Taking a cue from its famous portrayal in the motion picture Men in Black, and the retro futuristic design and scale of the building, the Museum of Science Fiction would be a permanent museum for everything science fiction.

The centerpiece could be a large scale model of the Starship Enterprise, as well as full scale models of other famous space vehicles on the main floor space – some or which can be boarded. This area could be weather protected by a retractable canopy, allowing open air visits when weather permits. The surrounding Mezzanine would allow visitors a higher vantage point for gathering and viewing the vehicles.

The enclosed spaces below the mezzanine would house 6 to 8 specific interest exhibits, some of which would change regularly to attract repeat visitors. In addition, the gift shop and snack bar areas would be located here.

The museum could be available for private events, award ceremonies, and other special events for the science fiction community.

The towers would house 1 or 2 observation decks and a themed restaurant.
