THE PAVILION FLOOR WAS A TERRAZZO NEW YORK STATE MAP. KEEPING THAT IN MIND, A NEW YORK STATE MAP PLATFORM IS PRESENT AT THE CENTRE OF THE PAVILION TO GIVE THE PUBLIC A FEEL OF THE OLD PAVILION, REINVENTING IT FOR THE 21ST CENTURY.

THE COVERED WALKWAY PROVIDES AMPLE SPACE FOR THE PUBLIC TO AMBLE AND RELAX. SEATS AND HAMMOCKS ALLOW USERS TO ENJOY THE VIEW AND THE PLACE.

THE MARKET PLATFORMS CONSIST OF MARKET STALLS FROM VARIOUS COUNTRIES AND REGIONS FACILITATING INTER-COMMUNITY INTERACTION.

TO MAKE THE STRUCTURE SUSTAINABLE AND SELF-SUFFICIENT, THE ENTIRE ROOF IS COVERED WITH TRANSLUCENT COLOURED SOLAR GLASS PANELS. ALSO, THERE IS PROVISION FOR RAINWATER HARVESTING. A GLASS 'BOWL' UNDER THE OPENING IN THE ROOF COLLECTS WATER AND CARRIES IT TO UNDERGROUND TANKS BY MEANS OF GLASS PIPES.
