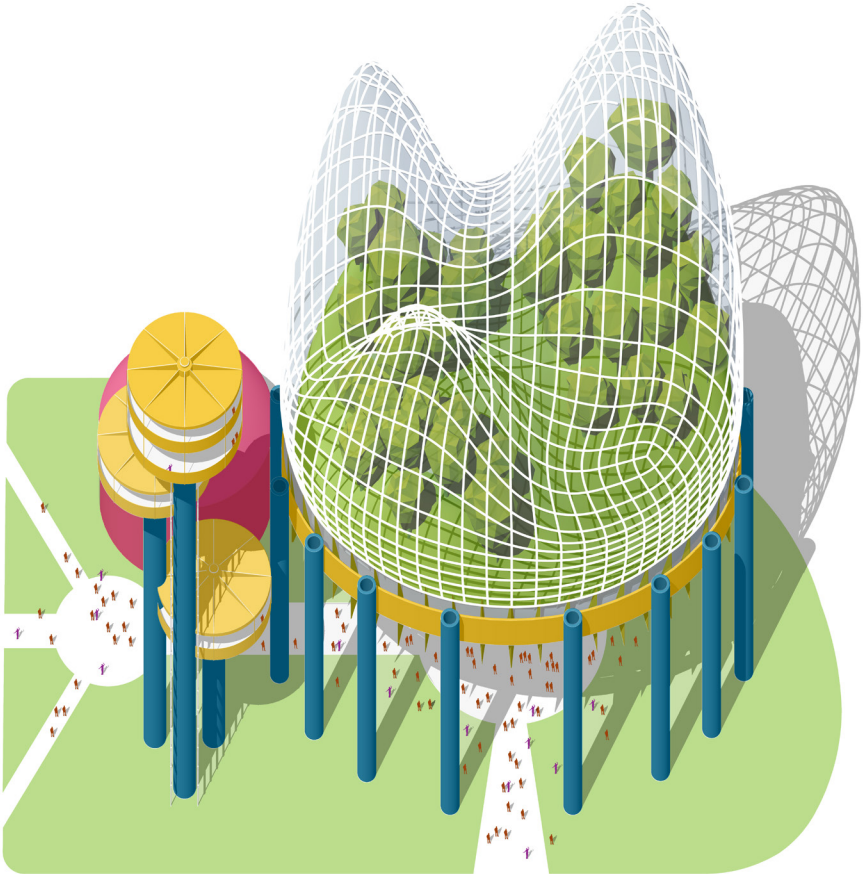


# Hanging Meadows
